





R/O Nagpur. Hereinafter called as service provider (PARTY NO.1)

AND

Hereinafter called waste generator (PARTY NO.2).

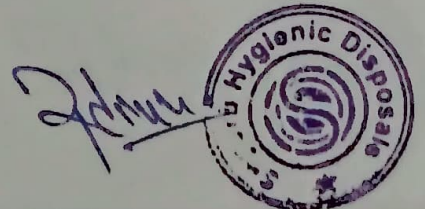
That the service provider / party No. 1 is having a Bio Medical waste disposal unit. And the service provider / Party No. 1 is engaged in the business of disposal of Bio Medical Waste.

That the waste generator / Party No. 2 is having its Hospital in the Name and style of **Government Ayurvedic College and Hospital at Raje Raghuji Nagar, Sakkardara Square, Umrer Road, Nagpur**. In the said Hospital, Waste generator is having **180 beds** of indoor patient and in house services generated a Bio-Medical Waste.

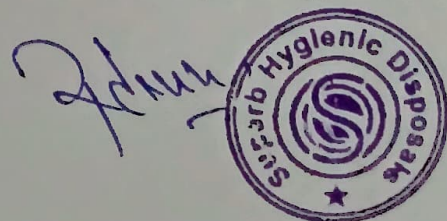
Party No. 1 the service provider and Waste generator agreed that this agreement is valid from **01/04/2025 to 31/03/2026**. And after the expiry of the said period of this agreement, the parties will renew the agreement on fresh terms and conditions as would be mutually agreed upon.

On the request of Party No. 2, Party No.1 has agreed to undertake the work of collection, transportation and disposal Bio Medical Waste generated in the Hospital/ Clinic/Laboratories of party No. 2 on the following terms and condition.

- 1) **Waste generator** hereby declares that in his Hospital, he is having **beds** for indoor patient and in house services like **Pathology, Blood Bank, OPD and X-ray unit**.
- 2) **Service provider / Party No. 1** has accepted the work of collection, transportation and disposal of entire Bio Medical Waste of the waste generator.
- 3) **The waste generator** will arrange itself non-chlorinated coloured plastic bags approved by pollution control board for stocking and packing of Bio-medical waste.
- 4) **The Waste generator** will arrange collection and proper segregation of entire Bio-medical waste generated in its various departments and wards as per the guidelines of the Bio-medical waste management and disposal rules 1998, and its segregation as per details annexed. Party No.1 has agreed to collect the Bio-Medical waste at source during 9 am to 6 pm or any other time, which may be mutually agreed upon.
- 5) **The waste generator** will pack the segregated Bio-medical waste as per rules at the collection end point in Colour coded bags label the said bags as per schedule IV (rule 6) of the Bio-medical waste (management and handling) rules 1998 and amended on 6th March 200 and 2nd June 2000, and 17th Sept. 2003 as per section 6, 8 and 25 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986. It is the responsibility of the Party No. 1 to collect, Transport and dispose of the Bio-medical waste.



- 6) **The waste generator undertakes to deliver to the service provider only the segregated Bio-medical waste generated on daily basis, general waste i.e. (*municipal solid waste*) is not to be put into the service provider's bags at all for any violation of the Bio-medical rules in this regard the waste generator shall be exclusively responsible.**
- 7) **The party No.2 will pay the payment, Which will be due against him within 15 days from the receipt of the bill for that particular month.**
- 8) **Taxes such as contract sale tax, service tax, service tax etc. if applicable shall be to the waste generators' account.**
- 9) **No change or modification or waiver of any of the terms of this agreement shall be effective unless agreed to in writing and signed by duly authorized officer of each of the parties hereto.**
- 10) **That the waste generator agreed that they will pay service provider disposal charges, approved by the rate schedule of memorandum of understanding between party No. 1 and Indian Medical Association and Nagpur Municipal Corporation. (Annexure - I)**
- 11) **Party No. 1 the service provider and Waste generator agreed that this agreement is valid for a period of 1 Year i.e. from 01/04/2025 to 31/03/2026**
- 12) **All disputes and questions in connection with this deed arising between parties shall be referred to the arbitration of the two arbitrator one to be appointed by each party and in case of their disagreement to an umpire appointed by the said arbitrator or in case of their default by the parties.**
- 13) **In the event there is any objection and / or notice for breach of the rules regarding transportation treatment and disposal of bio-medical waste, Party No. 1 shall be solely responsible in that behalf.**
- 14) **In the event the party No. 1 commits any default in the service the Party No. 2 shall be at liberty to discontinue this agreement with prior written notice of one month.**
- 15) **If Party No.2 prefers to close down the establishment permanently for what so ever reasons, the agreement shall stand cancelled on the month written notice/information by party No. 2.**
- 16) **This agreement is executed in Triplicate; one original signed copy will remain with party No. 2.**



- 17) The waste quantity will not be more than 1000 Kgs/Per month. If the quantity of BMW will be more than this then it will be charged extra @ 20Rs/per Kg.
- 18) Barcode sticker should be compulsory attached with Bio-Medical Waste Bags as per MPCB Guidelines.


